I am requesting funding for the City of Salem's Reducing Community Violence through Trust-Building and Smart Policing project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Salem. This project is located at 555 Liberty St. SE, Salem, OR 97301.

Funds will be used to add a crime analyst, software and hardware necessary for receiving and disseminating real-time intelligence, and two officers dedicated to acting on the intelligence and conducting community outreach with the funded position. These resources will shortly be used for convening stakeholders, developing a community-based strategy, securing memorandums of understanding with community partners, reducing shootings by 5 to 10 percent a year, and improving information sharing, transparency, and coordination with partners. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
