Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Family Promise of Tualatin Valley (FPTV) Family Shelter Facade Renovation and Roof Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Washington County, located at 155 North First Avenue, Hillsboro, OR 97224.

The funding would be used to replace the 18,000-square-foot roof with a TPO membrane and tapered drainage system; install additional roof drains, replace deteriorating façade panels, weatherize windows and PTAC wall penetrations, and replace framing members impacted by dry rot.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Family Promise of Tualatin Valley (FPTV) operates the largest family shelter in Washington County, providing year-round emergency housing and services to 175–200 children and their parents nightly. The shelter is an essential regional resource in the continuum of care for families experiencing homelessness. Federal investment will protect an essential regional shelter, prevent costly future structural failures, and ensure taxpayers' dollars support long-term, resilient community infrastructure.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
