I am requesting funding for the Horizon House 2.0 Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Marion County, located at 555 Court St NE, Suite 4247 PO Box 14500 Salem, OR 97309.

The funding would be used to upgrade and expand Horizon House; a licensed nine-bed residential treatment facility on the Oregon State Hospital campus operated by Marion County Health and Human Services.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Horizon House 2.0 will expand access to residential behavioral health treatment for individuals with severe and persistent mental illness in Marion County and surrounding communities. By increasing treatment capacity and providing crisis respite beds, the project will help reduce pressure on emergency departments, hospitals, and the criminal justice system while supporting long-term recovery and community reintegration. This investment strengthens the regional behavioral health continuum and improves outcomes for vulnerable residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
